

# **APPLICATION TEMPORARY FOREIGN STUDENTS**

## ALL LISTED REQUIREMENTS AND QUESTIONS TO BE COMPLETED, WITH BOTH PARENTS' SIGNATURES

- a) Certified copies of student's last 2 full school reports, and any remedial and/or psychological assessments
- b) Certified copy of student's passport, if available, and photograph/s of student
- c) Reference letter from current class guardian
- d) Letter of confirmation, preferably from the English teacher, that student's standard of English is adequate that he/she would be able to cope and not be at a loss because of language skill. (Should we find that the English language skills are inadequate, extra English lessons will be required, at an extra cost).
- e) Confirmation letter from your school regarding credit worthiness in respect of school fee payments
- f) Handwritten letter of introduction and motivation written by High School student about him/herself, with interests and why they would like to come to Cape Town
- g) An application fee of R500. This fee is not refundable
- h) Should the application be successful, <u>a copy of the passport stamped with study visa (in the name of our</u> school, if applicable, and air ticket prior to student's departure for South Africa
- i) Proof of payment of our school fees for hosted students, prior to departure for South Africa (not applicable for direct exchanges or families)

## APPLICATION PROCESS AND INFORMATION:

Acceptance is not guaranteed, and is subject to acceptance by the Class Teacher/Guardian and the relevant faculty, and a successful financial arrangement with our accounts/administration office. You will be advised of the decision after Faculty's confirmation.

- If successful, we endeavour to find a suitable exchange student or host family. We give recommended contact details for introduction, and arrangements with families are made direct.
- Once this is confirmed, you will receive our Acceptance forms, with acceptance letters for your application for a study visa (if applicable). We require all completed forms before departure for South Africa.
- School fees, if applicable, are payable 2 terms in advance, before departure for South Africa. This is not applicable for a direct exchange.
- Minimum period for a visiting student is generally 1 term/3 months, and preferably 2 terms/+-6 months.
- Minimum age is 16 years, for Class 10 or Class 11 for exchange students and visiting foreign students (not applicable for families).
- Our term dates are available on our website.
- NB the legal drinking and clubbing age in South Africa is 18 years.
- Should circumstances occur where behaviour makes it necessary for our school to send the student back home, this will be at the
  parents' costs.
- Students should arrange to bring and/or receive their own maths school work.

# **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

### FEE POLICY

The financial liquidity of the Constantia Waldorf School is dependent on the prompt payment of school fees by parents/guardians.

All monthly/termly fees are to be PAID IN FULL IN ADVANCE on or before the 1st working day of every month or prior to the start of each term.

#### METHODS OF PAYMENT

- 1. A monthly DEBIT ORDER or STOP ORDER payment over 12 months, January to December is our preferred method of payment.
- 2. Monthly (EFT) Electronic Funds Transfer or (CSH) CASH methods of payments may only be done over 10 months (January to October) by condition of entry arrangement.
- 3. Your child's full name and fee account reference number should appear on the deposit slip to be faxed to us at 086 260 1221 or emailed to junita@waldorfconstantia.co.za.
- 4. We prefer not to accept cash at school.

### EARLY SETTLEMENT of FEES

A 3% rebate is offered for annual fees paid in advance, by 31<sup>st</sup> January 2020. Interest of all fees payments made in advance will be retained by the school.

### ADMININSTRATION CHARGES

1. Failure by parents/guardians to make fee payments by the 1st working day of every month or prior to the start of the new term will result in a late payment charge of R250 per month.

2. Repeated late payments will not be allowed nor tolerated.

### NON or SHORT PAYMENT OF MONTHLY/TERMLY/ANNUAL FEES – POLICY and PROCEDURES

1. Outstanding fees of the previous MONTH/TERM /YEAR will be handed over to the attorneys of Constantia Waldorf School for collection. Parents/Guardians will be liable for payment of costs on the scale as between attorney and client, including collection charges.

2. Parents/Guardians will be requested to immediately remove the children from school.

(Only in exceptional circumstances, and at the discretion of the Board of Directors and Debtors Mandate Group, will a pupil be allowed to enter a new term if any portion of the fees of the previous month/term or year is unpaid.)

### WITHDRAWAL NOTICE

Once a pupil has entered the school, a minimum of 1 (one) term's/3 (three) month's written notice of withdrawal (or two terms at the end of Primary School) should be given to the accounts office. Written request for the refund or offsetting against unpaid fees of the Acceptance Deposit must be submitted to the accounts office.

If such notice is not given, a full term's fees/three month's, at the rate applicable for the next term in which the pupil would have been at school, shall be paid in lieu thereof. Likewise, if the school elects for any reason to terminate this contract, then it may do so, on giving the parent a term's written notice of its decision to terminate the contract at the end of the term in question, at which time the parent must withdraw the pupil. A CEMIS transfer certificate will be issued on the pupil's last day of school or when the fee account is fully settled.

### PARTICIPATION

It is important for parents and teachers to maintain regular contact. General information is sent out electronically through our weekly newsletter, The Grapevine. You would be expected to regularly attend Class Parent meetings, Parent talks, the Annual General Meeting and Festivals, as well as Introductory Courses in Waldorf Education and Parent Conferences which parents are asked to attend, if they have not previously done so, in order that our methods and expectations can be explained and supported. The school holds fundraising events during the year and all families are expected to play an active part in these events. Parents are held responsible for supporting our school's expectations and requirements.

### ON ACCEPTANCE

A CEMIS transfer out certificate or transfer letter must be obtained from the previous school and handed to the admissions office prior to commencement, for compulsory registration with the Western Cape Education Department.

### STUDY VISAS

Study visas in the name of our School (Constantia Waldorf School) or a permanent residence permit in the name of the student are compulsory for all Non-South African pupils prior to entry and a copy given to the admissions office.

PERSONAL PROPERTY: Constantia Waldorf School does not accept responsibility for any personal property brought to school.

DECLARATION: The Board of Directors of the Constantia Waldorf School reserves the right to make adjustments to the school fees and related charges from time to time, as it may deem fit.
